Dr. Sam Chand

Restructuring Your Leadership Roles in the Ministry and Marketplace

Dr. Sam Chand is a former Pastor, college President, and Chancellor but now serves as President Emeritus of Beulah Heights University. Dr. Sam Chand develops leaders through leadership consultations, resources, and speaking engagements.

My theme for today and my topic is Restructuring Your Leadership Roles in Ministry and Marketplace. Restructuring does not mean you already have this; you come behind it and paste on and add something. No, that's not what it's about. What it is about is that you must tear down. Number two, you must clean out. Number three, you must have a new blueprint. You've got to have new materials to rebuild and restructure the place.

Two Foundational Understandings - First, all restructuring is a critique of the past. So, if you restructure your church building, you are improving wherever there was; it is a critique of the past. You are improving on the past. Number two, all restructuring will be offensive to someone on a very personal level.

So, the first point is that all restructuring critiques the past. But most people, most of you, will not restructure for the second reason. You will not restructure for the second reason because it will be offensive to someone on a very personal level. All restructuring will be offensive to someone on a very personal level. And this number two reason is why most of you will be hesitant, apprehensive, and reluctant about restructuring. Because when you restructure, you're going to offend somebody. When you restructure, you will reposition, remove, or promote somebody.



So, there are five restructuring items of focus:

Number one is Personal. Personal is how you think as a leader. And as you start thinking about it, you'll get excited and fearful because you'll see possibilities and liabilities.

Number two, Personnel - How are you going to focus on those who are working for you? Proper people placement prevents problems.

Number three, processes: How you do things. Global challenges were not just about the pandemic but economic, social, cultural, religious, and political.

Number four, places - locations, on your org chart. Now, that's very important. I have discovered now that I'm a leadership consultant: I have clients on every continent except Antarctica and have clients everywhere.

Number five, is people - all affected by the outcomes, volunteers, family, members of your church, customers, etcetera, all affected by your ecosystem. So, it's not just the people you pastor but the customers you serve. It's not just the vendors that you help. It's not just your social or economic bubble. There are lots of people who are affected by how you restructure.

To be truly a great leader, it is very important to understand that you will get both congratulations and condolences.

For you to truly be a leader, you must be emotionally, mentally, and physically prepared to receive both congratulations and condolences. Here are four lessons of leadership.

Lessons of Leadership

Character: - Great destiny requires great character. Character can only be built by the experience you go through. You will need a great character that is big enough for the calling. The journey of leadership can be lonely and difficult. Leadership is sometimes sad; sometimes, you fear what could be next. As a leader, you need to free your mind always from the mindset of being liked by everybody; Jesus Christ was the perfect leader that ever lived; even unbelievers testified to that, but some people still disliked Him to the extent that they killed Him. Free yourself from the need of everybody's approval. People will honor you today, and the same people will dishonor you by the next day.

Commitment: - Commitment talks about consistency in your focus and discipline in your duties. Consider the story of David. After being anointed king, he returned to being a Shepherd. Consider his commitment to being a Shepherd boy, running errands yet still having time for his music. Destiny is launched from the discipline of duties. Greatness is something that you are blessed with. Leadership or greatness requires a significant amount of your time, learning, training, and developing yourself.

Courage: - Courage is the ability to do something you are frightened to do. It means strength in the face of pain. Faith and confidence to move



forward in the face of uncertainty. Faith requires courage.

There is a story in 1Sam. 14 from verse 1 - Jonathan here didn't tell his father, who was king; otherwise, protocols would have been required. God didn't promise us that it would be easy, but He promised us that we would be victorious. The presence of difficulties doesn't mean the absence of the promise of God.

As a leader, you can start small before it is big; start small. "You don't have to be great to start, but you have to start to be great"- Zig Ziglar. So, whatever that vision or idea is, just take a step and start. You have waited enough. God is the scriptwriter, the director, and the producer of your life; you are just an actor. The actor doesn't determine how the movie ends; the director does. So, trust the director.

Counsel: - Jonathan picked his armor bearer as his counselor. You can't go on this journey alone; sometimes, you need an armor bearer for God's vision. Sometimes you may be the armor bearer for someone else. In establishing yourself, ensure you create a business, not a job. A business is a system that you set up to produce a result. Don't just set up a job; set up a business. Set up a system to produce the kind of result you desire to achieve through the people you fix in places. Envision the life you want to live in the next five years. Do you want to go on vacation once a year or twice? Envision it. Consider or think about how much money is needed or will be needed by the business to finance the type of life envisioned.

Building Structure and Restructuring Your Brand

Mr. Lake Alder is the Founder and Principal of Alder Consulting, Nigeria's leading creative intelligence firm with offices in Lagos and London. He is credited with introducing branding as a discipline to Nigeria and has consulted on policy, politics, and business at the highest levels, locally and internationally. He authored several books and hosted a weekly radio business program, "Mining Your Business" with Lake Alder, on 92.3 Inspiration FM in Lagos, Nigeria.

Today we will be looking at structure, and I'll also be looking at branding. Now, our topic of deliberation is building structure and restructuring your brand.

The first thing you must note about restructuring or structuring a business is that it is imperative. Whether you run an organization, a church, an SME, or a corporation, it's an imperative. It is not optional. Structuring goes to the very heart of the blueprint of the organization. It determines success, defies failure, and regulates growth. Structuring has to do with the clear definition of roles within an organization and the integration of the parts into a cohesive role so that the organization can efficiently deal with a set of objectives.

Let me illustrate with a bit of my personal history, and I want to bring in some anecdotal evidence so we can relate to what I'm saying. I want to go back into my personal history so that you see what I've been through. Now, in the year 2000, that's 23 years ago, I fell terribly ill. Alder Consulting was young at this time. The staffing was even younger. I'm making the point that Alder Consulting survived despite my absence. I spent a year out of



the company, but the company survived despite my absence, and mind you, the people running the company were very young. They were in their twenties. The oldest ones may have been 25 or 26.

The company survived for six reasons:

Number one, I wasn't the sole signatory to the account. There were two or three other signatories to their account, number one.

Number two, we worked out a collegial system for handling briefs. Only some people can handle a brief. So many people handle a brief. So many people brought their perspectives to a brief.

Number three, I was not the sole face of the organization.

Number four, the enterprise wasn't domiciled in me. There are many entrepreneurs in that the enterprise is domiciled in them.

Number five, everyone's role and function were well defined.

Number six, and the last one, the company had a defined set of values and a corporate philosophy that we all subscribe to, the firm's ethos. Now, with a proper structure, the organization could have survived. There was, of course, the grace of God, but we consultants don't talk about God. We focus on reason and logic.

Today, I'm speaking about entrepreneurial structure and restructuring. And that is really a key topic for the world that we're in today. And whether you want the developing world or are in the developed one, we know that the private sector is key as an engine of economic growth and advancement.

The private sector is where we see the aggregation of all the entrepreneurial drive, that spirit of industry that gets up, and the expression of potential creativity, vision, and purpose, right? So, as an entrepreneur, you are literally doing more than just starting a business. You are carving out a process through which you help to identify opportunities, allocate resources, to create value, and solve problems, to meet the unmet needs of people.

From the beginning, it was clear that I wanted to build something that was smart, sustainable, and that would live past me.

Structure and restructure are a legacy conversation. It is a legacy conversation. And this is the first thing I want to put on the table that any entrepreneur looking at what they're doing today, no matter how small it is, no matter how many times you've gotten it wrong, understand



So, once you stay in that place where you are constantly looking at, "What is happening in my market? What is happening in my economy? What is happening with technology? How can I leverage this? What kind of new ideas are coming to me? What does the world need today?" When I look at the economy now, technology means there rarely are boundaries. We've been talking about globalization for years. We moved into the concept of localization, which is like big global but operates locally. Now technology is even bringing down all those walls. That means nothing is impossible for me. That means that I just need to find the niche, the assignment God has given me.

One of the problems that we find a lot of the time with entrepreneurs, and it's understandable, is many of us just have a vision, there's a burning in our hearts, and we jump in. We don't necessarily have the resources to create these big, gigantic great structures from the beginning.

And so, you must see yourself on a bigger assignment than just this min, "I'm just trying to hustle. I'm just trying to make it." No, no, no. You are on God's assignment. God told me clearly one day; he said, "Audrey, you are a builder of bridges. You are a financier, kingdom financier, builder of bridges between men and ministries." So, I'm very clear that I need to build, I need to continue to grow, scale, structure, restructure, whatever it takes to keep taking territory because I'm on God's assignment to build the kingdom.

Creating Structures for Success

Creating and sustaining structures for success.
So, what is a structure? A structure is a system that shows the distribution of roles and activities toward the achievement of the objectives of an organization.

So, to build structures anywhere, you must be clear about your vision and goals. For your organization, you've got to have a vision. And I say that vision is the ability to see people, places, and things. Not just the way they are but the way they could be.

To build structures, you need to be a systems thinker. Now, this is big. You need to be a systems thinker. On this point, I would like to use the human body for illustration. You see, the human body runs on systems, right? The excretory system, the reproductive system, and the respiratory system, right? The nervous system is a group of parts that carry out a specific function. So, when you say respiratory system, that's from the nose, you know, down to the windpipe and the lungs, whatever takes in oxygen and takes out carbon dioxide, that's that. All those parts together form a system. So, when I say that you need to be a systems thinker, most people cannot think beyond a part, part-time.



The benefits of having a structure. One, it shows the flow of communication. And in this instance, we're talking about an organization, right? It shows how communication flows in an organization. You know, at the end of the day, what really makes an organization is not the building or the equipment; it's the people in the organization. What makes a nation is more than just the geography, it's the people in the nation, right? So, the relationships and connections between people determine how successful we are in building and running an organization, a business, a church, or a ministry.

Having a structure creates culture, ah, culture, culture. That powerful word that literally, literally determines whether an organization will succeed or fail, culture, the way we do things that have been adapted and cultivated over time in the process of solving problems and resolving issues.

Structural Restructuring - Life and in Ministry

There are many structures in an organization that are needed for us to succeed. One important part is the visionary structure. Without a vision, the Bible says that the people perish. A vision tells us where we're going and how to get there.

For an organization, a church, or a ministry to achieve their corporate objectives, we need structures. We need a financial structure, we need a technical and IT structure, we need an administrative structure. The challenge is that many churches and pastors have neglected this aspect of administration or structure because of the spiritual nature of the church. And because of that, they are paying the price for it today.

You need structures to avoid chaotic moments because every vision, calling, or anointing without adequate structures in place might not show significant results. Here are five points to consider when we talk about structure and restructuring:


- Structure is the backbone of any organization.
 No organization can thrive without people,
 whether you are a church or otherwise. If you are buying and selling, you need people to buy from, and you need people to sell to. People are the greatest assets and structure. Without people, vision becomes frustration.
- Structure determines the pathway to our vision. It's important that we know where we are going; if not when we get there, we will not recognize it, or we might not even have an idea if we get there.



- 3. Structure should be able to take you further. There's a scripture I love a lot, Ecclesiastes 10:10. The NIV translation says if the axe is dull and its edge is unsharpened, more strength is needed, but skill will bring success. Because of constant changes in the landscape, structures should be reviewed periodically. Structure should not be cut in stone, so it cannot be reviewed.
- 4. Structure is about ability first, and loyalty becomes a plus. This is very important. Structure is about ability first, and loyalty becomes a plus. Someone said to me a few years ago, he said I cannot hire who I cannot fire.
- Structure should not be permanent that it cannot be tweaked or adjusted. Every structure should be subjected to constant reviews. It is the same thing at times with some doctrines of some churches.

Solution Night PraiseFest

We thank You, Lord, for Your faithfulness, kindness, goodness, and mercy. Tonight, we come together to praise You. Almighty God, speak to us in the next few minutes. May Your name alone be praised. In Jesus' name, we worship. To praise God is to exalt His name. If you miss the praise and worship, you've missed the service. Exalting God is to magnify, lift up, and esteem Him of the highest order. As we come together to praise Him, we exalt Him.

David understood the concept of praise well. In Psalm 7:17, he said, "I will praise the Lord according to His righteousness. And I will sing praise to the name of the Lord Most High." He praised God for being a righteous God, not for material blessings. In Psalm 9:1-2, David said he would be glad and rejoice in God, and he would sing praise to His name. When we praise God, we should focus on Him and not just sing songs.

In Psalm 34:1-6, David declares, "I will sing praise to your name, O Most High." He continues, saying, "I will bless the Lord at all times," emphasizing that he will praise God constantly, regardless of the circumstances. David proclaims that he will continually have God's praise on his lips and boast about the Lord. He knows that his praise will reach the humble and cause them to rejoice. David invites others to magnify the Lord with him and exalt His name together. However, it's essential to note that David started by praising God himself, and we must do the same. No one can praise God with us until we start praising Him first. Let us remember to carry our load and lift our voices in praise to the Most High.

In this passage, the speaker is emphasizing the importance of seeking the Lord and praising Him. He highlights that seeking the Lord does not necessarily mean physically looking for Him but rather speaking to Him through prayer and worship. The speaker encourages the listeners to seek the Lord with their mouths and praises and promises that God will hear them and deliver them from all their fears. He reminds them that in praising God, there is no fear because the focus is on God, and he encourages them to look to God, as those who do so will be radiant.

I encourage the congregation to magnify the Lord with him and exalt His name together. Seeking the Lord is not about physically looking for Him, but rather seeking Him with our mouth. David sought the Lord and He heard him and delivered him from all his fears. In praise, there is no fear because the focus is on God, and anything God cannot do does not exist. The people who looked to God were radiant.

The speaker encourages the audience to praise God for His righteousness. He quotes Psalm 9:1-2, which says that praising God should come from the heart and not just be lip service. He warns that it's possible to sing a song of praise without praising God and compares it to singing a nursery rhyme without understanding its meaning. The speaker emphasizes the importance of focusing on the one being praised, and not just going through the motions.

Forget Not His benefits Fiyinfoluwa Popoola



On Sunday, December 18, 2022, we held our annual Sovereign Army Teen Sunday where teenagers took over the entire service. One of our teenagers, Fiyinfoluwa Popoola, shared God's word with us in a sermon titled "Forget Not His Benefits". Here are some excerpts from the sermon:

There is a difference between thankfulness and thanksgiving. Thankfulness is the feeling that we have, a feeling of gratitude.

In the scriptures there is Godhead: The Father, The Son and The Holy Spirit {The Trinity}. Psalms 103 verses 3 and 10 speak about God forgiving our iniquities. Jesus Christ is the Redeemer, He doesn't do unto us according to our iniquities. His word says in Hebrews 8 verse 12 "For I will be merciful to their unrighteousness, and their sins and their iniquities will I remember no more". This shows a great difference between men and God. Christ doesn't account for any of our iniquities. He is always forgiving us. He doesn't even remember them. What a Mighty God we serve!

What is our response to all His benefits?

We must be useful in His kingdom. Christ said, "the harvest is plenty but there are few laborers."

What is the point of Christmas?

The Christmas season is unarguably the most joyful and boisterous season of the year. There's some lightness and merriment. It's just in the air. It's palpable. You could almost touch it... There's the trees and the lights...There's the gift getting and the gift giving... There is partying and the singing and the traveling. And then there's Santa Claus and Rudolph; unfortunately, most understand Christmas to be just a nice jolly holiday,

I'm not trying to be a party pooper, but it's easy to focus on the razzmatazz of Christmas,.. that we totally missed the point. It's like a couple obsessing over the wedding,... the point is really about their marriage. It is referred to as majoring in the minor. Yeah. So, our Christmas message today is a gentle reminder for all of us to major in the major.

Why is Jesus the reason for this season? Why did Jesus Christ, the Son of God, come to earth? Let's unveil it.

Number 1, sin, which is the biggest of all.



3 Financial mistakes I made and how to avoid them

There is a difference between those who become rich and those who remain poor or stuck in the middle class. The difference is that the rich make a conscious decision to pursue wealth and success, while the poor and middle class often don't make a deliberate effort to improve their financial situations. We have a responsibility to face our financial issues and work towards resolving them, rather than ignoring them.

Here are three financial mistakes I made, and how you can avoid them:

- 1. I used to think that if I became more spiritual, my money problems would take care of themselves, but that was a big mistake. I failed to realize that I am a spiritual being in an economic world, where money is essential for survival. I used to believe that if I just sought God and gave 10%, He would take care of me. But the king wants me to multiply, not just add to my wealth. I need to understand financial intelligence, not just spiritual intelligence, to succeed.
- 2. I used to think that money wasn't important, but that's a big lie. Anything that's not important stays away from you. I used to have a religious mindset that money wasn't important, and as a result, it stayed away



from me. I bought right into the enemy's strategy. I find that people in the church have their eyes on God, but not on their money, because they believe it's not important. I did the same thing.

3. I was relying on only one source of income. It's a common mistake to have only one source of income, like a job. If that one source disappears, you could be in financial trouble. 1 multiplied by a hundred thousand or a million is still a losing number if it's your only source. Instead, successful people have multiple streams of income, usually between six to ten.

I did not set any financial goals for my life. I prayed for an increase, but I never had any specific targets. Why do we set goals? We set them because we see big things and then we have to grow into our dreams. Some of you have never had a target, and that's why you've never hit it. So, I want to challenge you: if you're not a millionaire, you have to be at least a millionaire or a decamillionaire to live any kind of life in your future. Who's ready to make that decision today?







First, increase is simply anything that has become more than its original state. And a sphere is an area or range over or within which someone or something acts, exists, or has influence or significance. So in combining those two definitions, increase is essentially within your space of influence in which we have the power to control.

1. Spiritual Sphere

We understand in 1 Thess 5:23 that Man is a 3-Part being- Spirit, Soul and Body- and his spirit is an integral part of his composition. So, ensuring that one has a robust and ever-growing spiritual life is a non-negotiable pursuit. If one is not increasing, then retrogression is inevitable. It was said of John the Baptist in Luke 1:80, "So the child grew and became strong in spirit, and was in the desert till the day of his manifestation to Israel.". If the prophet who was anointed from the womb needed to grow and be strong spiritually, then we also need to do the same no matter how anointed we feel we are.

Mental Sphere

It is commonly said that the mind is a terrible thing to waste. This saying derives its inference from the fact that a mind that is not constantly stimulated and developed will eventually be unproductive and degenerate. The scripture teaches us in Prov 23:7 that who we are now is directly proportional to the quality of our mental life. Psychologists have also proven that our lives move in the direction of our most dominant thought. Bottomline, the more you focus and think of increase, the more your life will gravitate towards increase!

2. Physical Sphere

One gift we should all give ourselves this year, is the gift of good health. There's a faithful saying worthy of all acceptance, no matter how lofty your goals are and how structured your plans are, they are only dependent on the state of your physical health! 3 John 1:2 states "Beloved, I pray that you may prosper in all things and be in health, just as your soul prosperity". It is God's desire for His children to live healthy and productive lives but that can't happen if we continue to indulge in bad health habits. We can change this by being intentional and disciplined to make our health a priority. Taking simple steps like regular exercising (ie 30mins walk daily) and proper dieting will work wonders to your body if done consistently.

3. Financial Sphere

You have probably heard the expression that 'money makes the world go round'. In the natural, it does because it seems that almost everything that needs to get done evolves around money. We feed with money. We live with money. We clothe with money. We educate with money. And the list goes on. Coincidentally, the Bible also seems to agree in Ecc. 10:19 "A feast is made for laughter, and wine makes merry; But money answers everything." So, it is wise to have a reasonable respect for money and its management but never an unholy crave to attain it by all means.

4. Social Sphere


